Essential Duties & Responsibilities:				

- 1. Receives emergency and administrative calls and messages; operates the telephone and radio systems; dispatches fire department equipment, manpower to emergency and routine incidents and resources as outlined in department procedures.
- 2. Maintains written records, such as log books, journals and incident records.
- 3. Answers a variety of routine questions and refers questions to the proper fire department individual, outside department or agency.
- 4. Maintains inventory of portable radios and related equipment.
- 5. Use a computer workstation to look up property information, department pre-incident plans, hazardous materials information and/or other information, as required.
- 6. Operation of the communication console with a high degree of accuracy and attentiveness due to the critical nature of emergency communications.
- 7. Contact other organizations or jurisdictions, as required.
- 8. Monitor fire alarms directly tied to the fire department.
- 9. Answers and asks a variety of questions in order to determine the nature and extent of an emergency.
- 10. Participates in all phases of training necessary to acquire the knowledge and skills required of the position.

Minimum Qualifications:

Education: High School Diploma or GED

Experience: At least 1 year as public safety dispatcher desired. Basic computer operating skills, including but not limited to: word processing and paging programs, input and retrieve information from spreadsheets and databases. (Ability to speak a second language is desirable)

Licensure: State of Connecticut certification as a public safety telecommunicator. Valid CT drivers license

Knowledge/Skills/Abilities:

Must be able to read, write, and speak the English language. Must be able to communicate both in writing and verbally. Must be able to follow written and verbal directions. Ability to react quickly and calmly in an emergency situation. Ability to speak a second language is desirable. Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with associates and the public. Should have knowledge of the Borough of Naugatuck, such as major roads, landmarks and geographic locations prior to completion of the probationary period.
